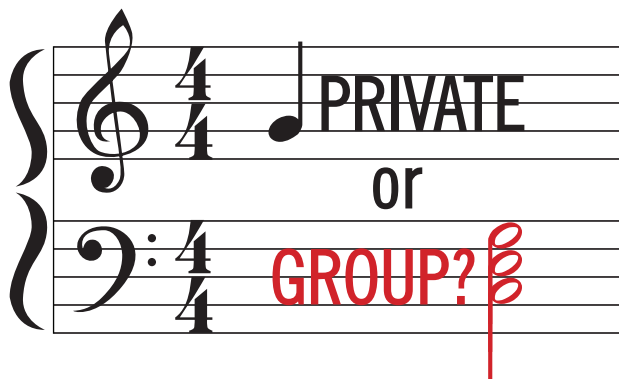


Whether you're a beginner or need to refresh your basic skills, **GROUP CLASSES** are fun and you may have a friend you want to study with!

For kids, it doubles as a way of introducing them to an instrument as well as new potential friends, and is helpful in gaining approval or social status.

If there aren't at least 3 people to fill a class in a particular age group, or if you wish to study privately, 30-minute **PRIVATE LESSONS** are also offered at a mutually convenient day and time. This way, instruction can be tailored to individual progress.

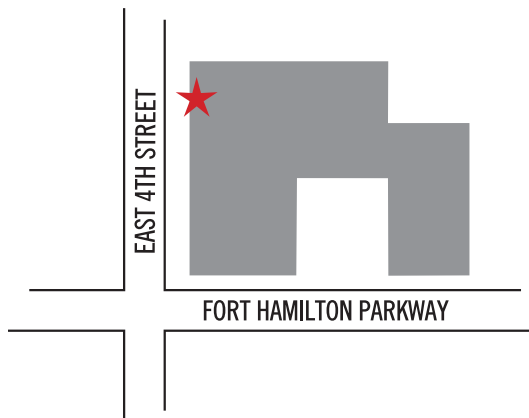

GROUP CLASSES taught Monday afternoons:
SEPTEMBER 15, 22, 29
OCTOBER 6, 20, 27 (No class Columbus Day)
NOVEMBER 10, 17, 24 (No class 11/3)
DECEMBER 1, 15 (No class 12/8)
Bonus lesson on DECEMBER 22 if five or more in class, or if Mr. Vaughan needs to reschedule a lesson.

PRIVATE LESSONS scheduled at mutually convenient day and time.

One (1) make-up lesson will be offered to any student who misses a class, based on availability, but only once.

If a class cannot be filled with students of similar age and ability, or is filled to capacity, or you cannot accept the day/time of the lesson offered to you, your payment will be returned.

A 12th “bonus lesson” will be added for any class with five or more students!

Students are required to practice at home between lessons.

Keyboards are provided for lessons, but each student must have access to at least a 48-key keyboard to practice on daily, though a 72–88 key keyboard is preferred.

Students are responsible to bring their music to each lesson.

No snacks, candy, or beverages allowed.

Parents are invited to observe lessons anytime.
